Throughout the internship program there may be an opportunity to travel up to one week at a time. This travel expense would be paid for by the company.

- Be assigned a business project to work on throughout the 10-week program to be presented to senior leadership the final week of the program
- Receive focused learning on how a Walmart store runs
- Ensure compliance with Company policies and procedures
- Model, enforce, and provide direction and guidance to hourly Associates on proper Customer service approaches and techniques to ensure Customer needs, complaints, and issues are successfully resolved within Company guidelines and standards.
- Participate in community outreach programs, and encourage and support hourly Associates in serving as good members of the community.
- Uphold the Company's Open Door Policy

Minimum Qualifications :

- Must be currently enrolled in an accredited college or university
- Must have an overall Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher
- Must have fewer than 30 credited hours of class before eligible for graduation
- For facilities that sell firearms, I acknowledge that the position for which I am applying will require successful completion of a firearms-specific Criminal Background Check (CBC) and Firearms Authorized Training
